1. Applicability

This information is applicable to all Model 380-010 Audio Selector Panels.

2. Subject

The 380-1 Rev 4.36 Assembly Drawing describes the Model 380-010 configuration as being MOD A. MOD A was not intended to be implemented to the Model 380-010 and the instructions indicating that it shall be identified on the nameplate as MOD 'A' are erroneous.

MOD A is applicable to many other derivatives of the Model 380-[] product family and involves readjustment of the noise gate circuit threshold in order to further squelch receiver audio leakage from the inputs to the outputs. This change did not apply to the 380-010.

All units returned with 'A' stamped on the cover shall have the 'A' removed.
